	Car	I go to work by car.
	Bus	She takes the bus to the city centre.
	Train	We travel by train.
	Plane	They fly by plane.

	Bicycle / Bike	He goes to school by bike.
	Taxi	We take a taxi to the hotel.
	Ship / Boat	They travel by ship.
	Underground / Subway	I take the underground every day.
	On foot	She goes to work on foot.

TRAVEL VOCABULARY

- Ticket - I buy a ticket.
- Airport - The plane leaves from the airport.
- Train station - The train arrives at the station.
- Bus stop - The bus stops here.
- Luggage - My luggage is heavy.
- Passport - I need my passport to travel.


- Hotel – We stay in a hotel.
- Map – I check the map.
